Water Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Water usage increased 10.44% for the month but is down year to date 6.13% compared to the same period for 2022. Metered revenue increased compared to the budget by \$15K but is down year to date by \$98K.

Project Update

The projects for 2023 are complete for the season. Dunn Street and Second Street will be completed in the Spring of 2024. AWD has been working diligently to prepare the 2024 budget. AWD has met with the City of Auburn Engineering Department to discuss Capital Projects and get a better understanding of the proposed projects for 2024. AWD plans to complete preliminary project work this winter to ensure the District is in the best position possible for the 2024 construction season. Currently AWD staff are maintaining hydrants, winterizing facilities & equipment.

Starting the third week of November, in a week's time, AWD received approximately two dozen water quality complaints throughout the distribution system. Customers were reporting discolored and yellow water. The complaints were investigated and many of the complaints confirmed. Crews were mobilized

to strategically flush areas within the distribution system to address the issue. The route cause is unknown but there are several factors that could have contributed. The factors are lake turnover, draining & filling Goff Hill Reservoir, and Fall flushing. The water quality calls have subsided substantially.

New Business

Trustee Appointments BOTH BOARDS

There is only one Trustee appointment that is open for 2024, Andrew Titus on the Water Board. We do still have one vacancy on the Sewer Board.

2024 Meeting Schedule BOTH BOARDS

See draft schedules in supplemental data. I don't see any conflicts with holidays in 2024.

Amendments to the Basic Agreement

In 1993, the District signed the Interlocal Agreement referenced as the "Basic Agreement." This was the Agreement drafted with the original grant of the filtration waivers for AWD and the Lewiston Water Division. The amendment proposes that future revisions of the Lake Auburn Watershed Boundary will only be adopted by the AWD Board of Trustees after notice and an opportunity for comment by interested parties, including the City of Lewiston, and will not be finally adopted until the watershed boundary changes have been approved by the Maine Drinking Water Program, similar to the process for their approval dated September 5, 2023.

Old Business

Water Quality Update

Turbidity is currently averaging around 0.8 NTU, very consistent with last year at this time. The lab has been watching biomass (algae) closely. We had a large rain event on 12/11 and we had to open the outlet dam 150 turns.

2024 Budget, Final

The Sewer Board has not yet taken action or discussed in detail the Cost of Living Increases (COLA) for 2024. The Water Board took a vote at the November Trustee Meeting to only implement a 2% COLA.

I would like both Boards to consider moving ahead with a 3.2 % COLA for several reasons.

1. The District conducted its last wage comparison in 2022 which did not take into account one of the largest COLA increases in the last 15 years and I feel it has left us behind in the competitive market. If we don't keep up with the COLA increases, we will fall further behind.
2. For the first time in three years, we are seeing an increase in our health insurance premiums. This increases the cost to the District and the employee equally.
3. For the past 2 years the District has given incentive bonuses to all employees. The newly adopted incentive program will not result in a 100% payout. My expectation is that it will be less than 50%. These two factors alone will decrease the average employees' take home by more than 3.2%.

Below is a history of District COLA increases, the recommended CPIU and other expenses. I also reached out to area utilities to see what they were implementing for 2024.

Sewer Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Metered revenue for sewer is \$25K over budget for the month, but still under budget YTD by \$26K, less than 1%. The cash balance at the end of November was \$1.1M, relatively unchanged from October.

Project Update

The projects for 2023 are complete for the season. W-6 Station Upgrade will be completed in the Spring of 2024. ASD has been working diligently to prepare the 2024 budget. ASD has met with the City of Auburn Engineering Department to discuss Capital Projects and get a better understanding of the proposed projects in 2024. ASD plans to complete preliminary project work this winter to ensure the District is in the best position possible for the 2024 construction season. Currently ASD staff are making a final push to clean as many sewer mains as they can before freezing temperatures limit the use of the Vactor truck.

New Business

ARPA Allocation \$100,000

Auburn City Council has approved allocation \$100,000 of remaining ARPA funds to assist with the identification of inflow that is affecting the Miller Street sewer interceptor. There is an additional \$100,000 allocated in our budget for this study. The District will distribute an RFP in January. We hope to have proposals at our January Trustee meeting for the Boards to review.

LAWPCA Apportionment & Financials

TSS Discussion

I'm working with LAWPCA to develop a sampling plan for a couple of industries here in Auburn. We just don't have enough information to determine the source at this time.

CSO Tank

LAWPCA received two qualified bids for the CSO Design Build Bid. The proposals were ranked and both scored similarly. Sargent submitted a bid of \$26,275,000 and MHW's bid was \$36,722,930.83. The Authority voted in favor of notifying Sargent of the intent to award at it's December meeting and a full project award date of January 12, 2024

Compost Facility Tour

Trustees Moulin and Cavanagh were able to tour the compost facility with myself and Travis Peaslee. This facility has been moth-balled for the last three years since it was shut down. The Authority continues to expend resources doing the bare minimum to maintain everything. Recently the City of Lewiston asked to use the facility as temporary cold storage. They mobilized equipment to the site and it resulted in multiple complaints from abutters so the process was stopped. At this point Planning Board approval is needed for a change of use of the facility.

Old Business

Washington Street Pumping Station Design

We have received the preliminary design plans for the Washington Street Pumping Station. I plan to apply for Clean Water SRF funds for this project in 2024.

November 15, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Trustees of the Auburn Water District was held in person at the Auburn Water District office at 268 Court Street on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 at 4:00pm.

Members present: Robert Cavanagh, Dan Bilodeau, Jason Pawlina, Andrew Titus (Treasurer) and Stephen Milks (President) and Mayor's Representative. Also present: Michael Broadbent, Superintendent and Matthew Waite , Asisstant Superintendent.

On motion of Jason Pawlina, seconded by Robert Cavanagh it was voted: **To approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of October 25, 2023.**

OPEN SESSION - As no one from the public was in attendance, the Open Session was closed.

FINANCIAL REPORT- Tanya continues to assist the District with its financials as the GL accounts had not been reconciled since July. Maine Rural Water will be at the December meeting. Revenues are down. It has been a wet year. We are looking at a deficit budget. Cash on hand is good.

Trustee Robert Cavanagh questioned the gull management being over budget. Superintendent Broadbent explained that some years are lighter than others and that it all depends on migration and lake conditions. Erica Kidd oversees the gull management.

RATIFY PAYMENT OF BILLS

On motion of Robert Cavanagh, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, it was unanimously voted: **To ratify the payment of bills in the amount of \$501,121.51 dated October 1, 2023-October 31, 2023.**

Trustee Andrew Titus commented on the Watershed also being over budget. It appears that there were some billing errors and we need to get a better handle on the numbers.

ACTIVITY REPORT /PROJECT UPDATE - It is the end of construction season and the crews are taking care of repairs. We are conducting proactive checks of all of our facilities.

The Eastside Taylor Pond Project has been put on hold and the project is to be re- evaluated. Fall flushing is 60% complete. Stable Ridge has satisfied all of our requests and we have the necessary software. Phase II is underway.

PUBLIC HEARING – To review proposed amendments to the By-Laws for the Protection of Lake Auburn, Level 1 Intake Restricted Zone and review Watershed Boundary Map.

Stephen Beale was in attendance. He told the Board that saw the 3D Model Report and had been to all the meetings and is in agreement with the new boundary line.

The By-laws language has been amended to be consistent with the map.

The Public Hearing was closed.

On motion of Andrew Titus, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, is unanimously voted: **To adopt the Lake Auburn Watershed Boundary and Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Zone map:**

The Auburn Water District adopts the official Lake Auburn Watershed Boundary and Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Zone map dated November 15, 2023 as presented in the Board Packet, inclusive of modifications mapped by CDM Smith in a technical memorandum dated July 31, 2023 and accepted by the Maine CDC Drinking Water Program as a revision of the source water protection boundary by letter dated September 5, 2023. By adopting this updated map, the District repeals the adoption of the amended watershed boundary in its vote of April 20, 2022.

On motion of Dan Bilodeau, seconded Andrew Titus, it was unanimously voted : **To amend the by-laws pertaining to the Level 1 Intake Restricted Zone:**

The Auburn Water District amends the By-laws for Protection of Lake Auburn to amend the delineation of the level 1 Intake Restricted Zone by adding the following underlined language: “Consisting of the shoreline of Lake Auburn upland to the closest roadway, or to the watershed boundary if that is closer to the Lake as depicted on the official Lake Auburn and Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Zone map on file with the Auburn Water District, and the surface of the Lake...”

Trustee Andrew Titus wanted to commend everyone for working on this. It is a step in the right direction.

OLD BUSINESS –

WATER QUALITY UPDATE -The turbidity is trending below average. The lake turnover has occurred. This will help restore oxygen levels throughout the water column.

2024 PROJECTS – Assistant Superintendent Waite met with the City. They have a lot of proposed projects for 2024. He presented the Trustees with an overview of Capital Project Planning. It is a very aggressive plan. The cost for the Lead Project is an unknown. Stephen Milks suggested that we apply for Grant monies to get this work done.

November 15, 2023

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NEW BUSINESS

HEALTH INSURANCE OPTIONS – Cross Insurance is proposing a 5% increase. Maine Municipal Association would be higher. We need to lock in for 2024.

On motion of Andrew Titus, seconded by Robert Cavanagh, it was unanimously voted: **To remain with Cross Insurance for 2024 with a 5% increase.**

EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE PLAN REVIEW – The District is looking to transition from the retention bonus to an Incentive Plan. Many of the employees do not have operator's licenses which is a requirement in the job description. This would increase the overall performance of our organizations. If an employee meets his job description, he/she would get \$1000. There would be opportunities for employees to obtain and retain valuable skills. The incentive would cap out at \$2000.

On motion of Dan Bilodeau, seconded by Andrew Titus, it was unanimously voted: **To approve the Incentive Plan as presented.**

PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES HANDBOOK UPDATES - Superintendent Broadbent reviewed the changes made to the handbook.

On motion of Robert Cavanagh, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, it was voted: **To approve the changes to the Personnel Policies and Procedures Handbook as presented.** 1 abstention

Trustee Andrew Titus feels that we are doing too much. The District provides good benefits and salaries. Trustee Dan Bilodeau said that there is no need to micro manage. We need to support the staff. He is in favor of what is being done.

DRAFT 2024 BUDGET -The District is assuming 0% growth, a 5% increase in health plan and a 3.2% COLA.

WATERSHED EDUCATION AND OUTREACH - This position is currently a part-time position and looking to make it a full time position. Trustee Stephen Milks wanted to know what that person does all day. He recommended to keep the Watershed Protection line item at \$85,000 which was the budgeted amount for 2023. Trustee Jason Pawlina supported that recommendation.

On motion of Jason Pawlina, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, it was unanimously voted: **To flat line the Watershed Protection budget line item to match the 2023 budgeted amount of \$85,000.**

BOND PAYMENTS – The Vactor Truck has been added. No bonds are due to expire until 2027.

COLA CHANGE -

On motion of Andrew Titus, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, it was voted: **To change the COLA from 3.2% to 2%. Passes with 3 in favor/2 against**

November 15, 2023

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There will be further discussion of the COLA at the joint meeting on how to handle the vote. It was agreed that if both boards disagree on the COLA it will be included in the budgets at the recommended 3.2%.

SUPERINTENDENT EVALUATION - It was suggested that each Trustee write their own evaluations and send them to Jason Pawlina.

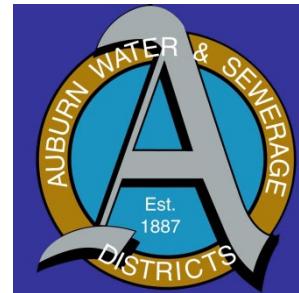

**FIRST AMENDMENT
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
FOR LAKE AUBURN WATERSHED PROTECTION**

This First Amendment to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement For Lake Auburn Watershed Protection is made on the _____ of _____, 202_____, by and between the City of Lewiston (“Lewiston”), a municipal corporation, the Trustees of the Auburn Water District (the “AWD”), a Maine quasi-municipal corporation, and Inhabitants of the Town of Turner, all located in the County of Androscoggin and State of Maine, for the purposes of more specifically identifying the boundary of the Lake Auburn watershed and the process for future changes to that boundary.

WHEREAS, on June 29, 1993, Lewiston, the AWD and Town of Turner entered into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Lake Auburn Watershed Protection (the “Basic Agreement”), pursuant to 30-A M.R.S., Chapter 115;

WHEREAS, the Basic Agreement describes the term “Watershed” of Lake Auburn as “cover[ing] approximately 15.31 square miles”;

WHEREAS, the AWD has adopted bylaws, as amended, that separate the Watershed into four zones of protection each which is defined by the bylaws and is specifically identified and mapped on the official Lake Auburn and Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Zone map on file with the Auburn Water District (the “Official Watershed Map”);

WHEREAS, Lewiston filed a Declaratory Judgment action against AWD in the Maine Superior Court, on or about May 12, 2022, challenging AWD’s revision of the Watershed boundary and the amendment of the Lake Auburn and Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Zone map in a vote of the AWD Board of Trustees taken on April 20, 2022, and said litigation remains pending in the Superior Court, Business and Consumer Docket No. BCD-CIV-2022-031;

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2023, Lewiston and AWD submitted a joint request to the Maine Drinking Water Program with an accompanying map to re-delineate, pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2001(20-A), those areas of the Source Water Protection Area of Lake Auburn that fall within a 148-acre contiguous parcel of land depicted on the maps identified as the “Gracelawn Parcel”, within the City of Auburn;

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2023, the Maine Drinking Water Program (the “MDWP”) approved a change to the watershed boundary line through the Gracelawn Parcel after CDM Smith completed a three-dimensional visualization and analysis model of existing/historical data to investigate groundwater flow in the parcel;

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2023, the Auburn Water District Trustees amended the Official Watershed Map to reflect the updated Watershed boundary line through the Gracelawn Parcel;

WHEREAS, on _____, the City Council of the City of Auburn amended the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Overlay District to reflect the updated Watershed boundary line through the Gracelawn Parcel;

WHEREAS, disputes about the location of the Watershed boundary line through the Gracelawn Parcel have played out in engineering studies and reports, actions of municipal and quasi-municipal legislative bodies, direct citizen legislative action, a lawsuit, and regulatory action;

WHEREAS, the AWD and Lewiston have cooperated to protect the water quality of Lake Auburn and minimize rates for their customers since before they entered into the Basic Agreement, and their cooperative partnership continued over the last two years despite disagreements regarding land use and zoning changes in the Watershed; and,

WHEREAS, the AWD and Lewiston wish to avoid future disagreements about the specific location of the Watershed by entering into this Agreement to memorialize their shared current understanding about the specific location of the boundary of the Lake Auburn Watershed, and to agree on a process for changes to that boundary; and so,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises and undertakings in this Agreement, the City of Lewiston, Auburn Water District and the Town of Turner hereby agree to amend the Basic Agreement, as follows:

A. The parties agree that to understand, interpret, effectuate, or enforce this Agreement or the Basic Agreement the term “Watershed” shall mean the portions of the City of Auburn, Town of Turner, Town of Hebron, Town of Buckfield and Town of Minot that contribute surface water or groundwater to recharge Lake Auburn as identified and mapped on the Official Watershed Map, which may be revised and amended from time to time by the Trustees of the Auburn Water District as provided herein.

B. The parties agree that, based on current data, the Official Watershed Map that the Auburn Water District trustees adopted on November 15, 2023 accurately identifies and maps the Watershed.

C. The Auburn Water District pledges, covenants and agrees that so long as the Basic Agreement remains in effect it will not revise or amend the Official Watershed Map, except after receiving MDWP approval pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2001(20-A). Before seeking MDWP approval Auburn Water District shall provide notice of a specific proposed change to the Official Watershed Map to the Superintendent of the City of Lewiston Water Division, to the Chair and Vice Chair of the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission, to the City Administrator of the City of Auburn, by publishing it to its website, and pursuant to any other means that the Auburn Water District regularly notifies the public of its meetings. No less than 30 days after providing such notice, after considering comment by the City of Lewiston, the City of Auburn, the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission or the public, the AWD Board of Trustees may

recommend a proposed change to the Official Watershed Map. After such recommendation, if any, the AWD shall seek MDWP approval of the change to the Watershed Map, pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2001(20-A). After the AWD receives MDWP approval or direction, the AWD shall revise and amend the Official Watershed Map consistent with such approval or direction.

D. The parties agree that this Agreement represents a written amendment to the Basic Agreement solely to clarify the location of the “Watershed” as used in the Basic Agreement, and the terms of further revisions or amendment of the Official Watershed Map, and that all further provisions of the Basic Agreement that are not inconsistent with this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

E. The parties agree that this Agreement is entered into in multiple duplicate originals, each of which may be taken as an original and shall be interpreted, enforced, and applied in accordance with the laws of the State of Maine. No amendment shall be effective unless in writing and signed by the party against whom enforcement is sought.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have each caused this instrument to be executed and delivered on their, behalf by their duly authorized representatives as set forth below, as of the day and year first specified above.
