Water Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Water gallons sold increased 2% from prior year leaving revenues favorable \$118k. The year ended with a variance in overall expenses of \$232k. Capital spent was \$630k. The year ended with \$3.3 million cash on hand. These are preliminary numbers for 2022 before final numbers are adjusted with the audit. The office is preparing for the upcoming audit in February.

Water Quality Update

The turbidity (clarity) of Lake Auburn continues to run above average. Turbidity was over 1 NTU for 8 days of December, peaking with the rain event Christmas week. During this storm there was a culvert malfunction that caused a breach of water over Lakeshore Drive. We opened the outlet dam for two weeks to bring the Lake level back to normal levels. These events are a contributing factor to the higher NTU's in December/January. So far in January we have been over 1 NTU for 12 days. The Lake has skimmed over with ice and is currently around 75% covered. Fecal numbers have come down from the peak we saw the second week of December. USDA did a good job keeping season bird migrations off the Lake before freeze up.

We expect to receive a proposal from Dr. Ken Wagner in February, Dr. Wagner is providing an action plan with alum treatment options for our consideration. Once we have the plan we can review with Lewiston and all Lake Auburn Stakeholders.

Project Update

Our crew worked to clear a water main rite-of-way between our Hardscrabble reservoir and Brentwood Drive. There were two large dead trees on our property that were over hanging a neighboring home, they have now been removed.

We were plagued by a number of water main breaks in December, we ended the month with 6 breaks that pushed us over our total for 2022.

We're busy working on capital project planning and we would like to order materials in January for the 2023 construction season. We've confirmed the Hotel Rd project, Second Street project proceed as presented in 2023. I would also like to proceed with the check valve replacement project at the Hardscrabble tank site.

-ACTION ITEM-

Request for approval of budgeted estimates in the amount of \$212,000 for Hotel Rd and \$93,600 for Second Street and \$50,000 for Hardscrabble check valve replacement. Action is requested to approve pre-ordering of materials to complete necessary water main replacement and infrastructure improvements.

Sewer Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Sewer metered sales ended the year favorable \$111k and new connections were up \$27k. The overall variance in expenses ended the year at \$182k. Cash ended the year at \$1.5 million. These are preliminary numbers for 2022 before final numbers are adjusted with the audit. The audit is scheduled for the first full week of February.

Project Update

The crews installed the generator pad, control panel and conduit for the new generator for the E-3 pumping Station. All we need now is the Generator which is expected to be delivered by the Trustee meeting.

Stable Ridge Development Phase 1, the developer's contractor completed the installation of the sewer mains and provided inspection videos for our review. Along with this we have also received from the developer the necessary easement paper

work for the mains. We identified a couple of deficiencies reviewing the inspection videos; however, the contractor has already corrected the issues.

43 Second Street, illicit sewer connection. In 2023 the City is planning to re-construct Second Street in New Auburn. During pre-construction video inspections it was discovered that there was an illicit discharge, however it was not clear initially where it was coming from. After some investigation it was found that the sewer service for 43 Second Street is connected to the storm water system and unfortunately the building has roof drains and those are connected to the sewer system. The contractor clearly got the lines crossed. We will be separating the sewer service this month and the roof drains will come out during the construction project.

Cost Apportionment

Flows for December once again favored us and we ended the year \$15,773.48 in the black. The average apportionment for 2022 was 64.08% / 35.92%.

Both Boards

We're working to determine the capital projects lists for 2023, we expect to have those finalized by February.

Trustee Appointments in 2023

The appointment committee will be meeting at the end of January/early February 2023 (exact date has yet to be determined). The goal is to have appointments go before the Council before March 6th. FINANCIAL REPORT UPDATE

Revenues are favorable \$158k. The variance in expenses is now up to \$235k. All projects will be closed out at year end and none will be carried over into the new year. November ended with \$3.1 million cash on hand.

RATIFY PAYMENT OF BILLS

On a motion of Robert Cavanagh, seconded by Eric Gould, it was unanimously voted: **To ratify payment of bills** in the amount of \$264,135.95 as shown on the printout dated November 1, 2022 – November 30, 2022.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Pam Rousseau was in attendance from the public. She had no comment.

ACTIVITY REPORT / PROJECT UPDATE

There were two main breaks in November on the Veteran's Day Holiday. Both repairs went well with minimal interruption to customers. Gate valves have been moved down for plow season and all hydrants are in service.

The 555 Court Street development filed a PUC complaint regarding the upfront maintenance fee in the District's agreement to take over the water system. The PUC ruled in favor of the Development, stating the upfront fee is unjust. The District has submitted an appeal to the PUC and will not take over ownership of the water system. The water system at 555 Court Street will be private.

NEW BUSINESS

Water Quality Update

The Lake turned-over November 18th which de-stratified the water column, sending oxygen throughout. The long-term water quality consultant, Dr. Ken Wagner, has been contacted regarding the quality of water and health of the Lake. He will be submitting a report with recommendations. It will be asked that the report include internal and external phosphorus loading percentages.

November had a big influx in migratory gulls on the Lake. The USDA was successful in using scare tactics.

2023 Budget - Final Draft

The two changes to the final draft of the 2023 budget are: an increase of \$32k in the UV Treatment Plant due to anticipated chemical costs and the removal of the excavator payment on the capital equipment. The final payment was made on the excavator this month.

CEI was hired by the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission to conduct a peer review of the FB Environmental report provided to the City of Auburn. The report was presented to LAWPC on 12/7/22. LAWPC will hold a workshop on the report 1/10/23.

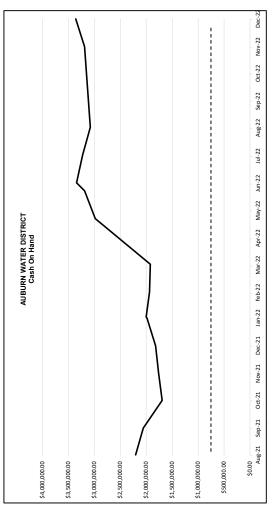

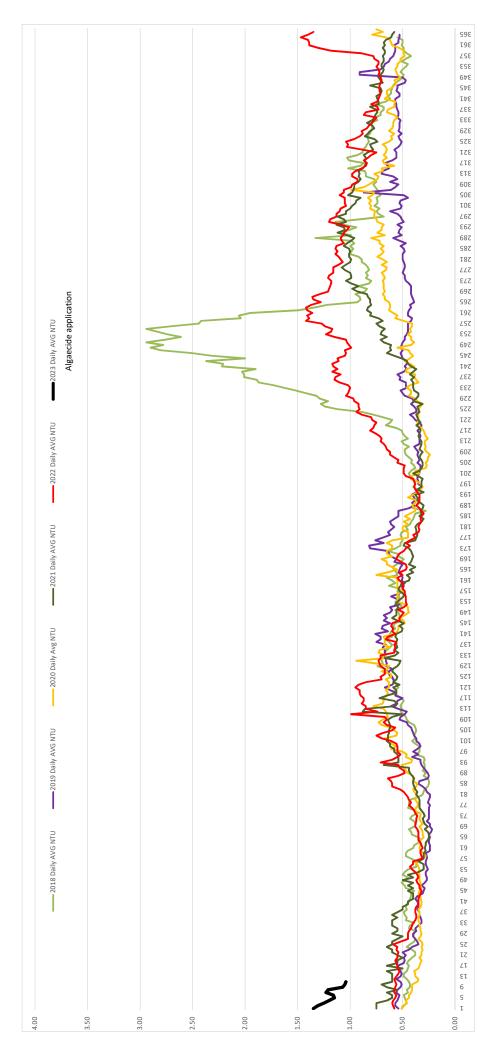

Re: Stable Ridge Booster System

The following is a summary of the interactions AWSD staff has had with the Stable Ridge Development. As you will see there have been many conversations regarding this system over the last year. I do have all of the written correspondence to back up this summary if anyone wishes to review it.

Typical interactions between the District and developers occur at plan review committee meetings, the plan review committee is made up of all City departments. The group reviews and comments on all plans before they go to the planning board for review. Typically staff comments from the plan review group are passed onto the planning board for consideration.

February, 2022

The Stable Ridge Development was a little different, I was contacted by the design engineer Terradyn Consultants before the project was presented to the plan review group. I reviewed the plans and presented written feedback on the proposed water and sewer infrastructure within Stable Ridge. I reported that I tested the pressure in the area of the development and that there were limitations. I suggested further testing and that there may need for a limited-service agreement and booster pumps systems to serve the development. I summarized my comments in a memo and sent them to the design engineer and City planning staff Eric Cousens and John Blais.

March, 2022

The plans for the Stable Ridge Development, Phase 1 were reviewed at a regular meeting of the Plan Review Group. I brought copies of my memo that I sent in February and voiced my concerns to the group. The plans that were presented to the group were un-changed from what I had originally reviewed in February.

April, 2022

Phase 1 of the Stable Ridge Development was approved contingent on the owner signing a limitedservice agreement with the District prior to receiving a building permit.

A week after the approval I was contacted by the site contractor KRY Construction, they wanted to order the water main materials to start construction on the system. I asked to review the plans with the contractor so that I could develop a materials list for the project. We met the next day, upon review of the plans we discovered that there were no plans for a water booster station. I told the contractor that I will develop the materials list but would hold off on ordering the materials as the list would change depending on the design of the system.

I sent a memo to the designer of the Development and City Planning Staff outlining my concerns with the now approved project.

The owner hired Haley Ward to provide engineer assistance and to determine if a pump system is needed. The District met with Haley Ward several times and assisted with the collection of flow/pressure data on two separate occasions.

The District provided the owner and Haley Ward with a copy of the Contract that we executed with the Poland Inn for their booster station.

May, 2022

The District received a report from Haley Ward showing that they determined the water pressure at their proposed main connection would not fall below 20 psi. Therefore, they would not need a limited-service agreement. However, they did determine that the water pressure is not adequate to supply sufficient water pressure for both domestic and fire protection services. The owner expressed verbally that they would build a booster station with the intention of the District taking over ownership. I sent a letter to the owner explaining that we will not make a commitment to accept the station until it has been through a, legal, technical and financial review by the District and that ownership and responsibilities would have to be defined in an agreement.

July, 2022

The District received the preliminary design of the water booster system, we reviewed the design and offered comments. There were several un-answered questions at this point and I outlined those in an email to the owner.

September, 2022

I made repeated attempts to schedule a meeting with the owner to settle the un-resolved issues.

October, 2022

Sid and I met with the owner here at the District, we gave her a copy of a draft agreement for the District to take over ownership of the station. This draft did not have actual cost because at that time we did not have the information from the owner, particularly on the construction of the pump house. We also discussed the need for a regulatory review by the Drinking Water Program, the need of a

technical and hydraulic review by the District's consultant. executing an agreement that could be reviewed by the PUC was still a priority.

The owner paid for the technical and hydraulic review of the pump station plans and the work was completed by Wright-Pierce before the end of October.

We received notice from the PUC that the owner had filed a complaint that the costs associated with the agreement were not fair. The District filed all necessary correspondence in a timely manner to satisfy the complaint.

The District conducted main testing for the water mains installed within the development.

At the end of the month, I provided the owner with a summary of outstanding items; final pump approval, station start-up, DWP review, Utility easements for all mains on private property. Because at this time the PUC complaint was still under review it had not been determined where the meters would be located. We outlined that these conditions need to be settled before the water mains could be activated.

November, 2022

I provided the owner with a status update, the District approved of the pump design, we approved of the generator selection, however we called out an issue we saw with the transfer switch. Hydraulic review is complete and we accepted the findings by Wright-Pierce. We had received DWP approval and we outlined the conditions of that approval. We pointed out that we still had not received feedback on the Draft agreement. We had not yet received submittals for the proposed building including detailed costs to determine the anticipated cost of operation, as-builds/easements for the mains, how the generator will be fueled and operated, etc. There was still an un-resolved PUC CAD complaint and most importantly we had not come to an agreement on ownership. The sewer mains that were installed needed to be inspected, and the water and sewer connection fees would need to be paid.

We received ruling from the PUC that we could not charge for upfront costs and perpetual maintenance, the District filed an appeal to the ruling.

We notified the owner that we would proceed with the understanding the water booster station and mains would be privately owned and operated.

December, 2022

The owner paid for the water meters and sewer connection fees and the main was activated as a private main. Meters have now been installed in two buildings.

The District was notified by the owner that the State Fire Marshalls office would not approve of the design of the fire pump system as a private system. The District worked with Attorney Pross to develop three potential options to move forward without causing a delay of occupancy to the owner.

Current status

The pumps are in but there is start-up and testing that needs to take place. We assisted the owner with getting water to the building and with the pump installers helping to get the system running for testing.

We received a call yesterday from the AFD. They raised the concern over who bares the responsibility of Firewatch in the event the fire pump fails or is without power for a prolonged period. We're working to incorporate that into the agreement.

The District conducted a pole of the Trustees and there was consensus to work with the owners and accept ownership, contingent upon the outcome of the appeal the District may charge up front costs in the future. We have been working with the owner to amend the agreement to capture these items and to outline future operations. This is in process

I am concerned that we have not yet properly taken a vote to take action on any agreement. The pole that was conducted via-e-mail last week is not an approved process for the District to make decisions such as this. I would recommend that we call a special meeting next week as long as we have an agreement that the owner of Stable Ridge agrees to. We can discuss the agreement in executive session and then take a vote in open session to authorize an agent of the District to sign the agreement. I feel this is important because the last public discussion we had on this matter at our December meeting was that this booster station and main extension would be private.
