#### Water Trustees

#### Financial Report Highlights

Water sales are down 3.5% from this time last year leaving a \$25k variance in metered revenue. Overall, there's a \$14k variance in expenses. Capital work is in full swing, the District has spent \$180k through the end of April on projects. The month ended with \$3.3 million cash on hand.

#### Project Update

The Hotel Road main elimination project has gone well. All of the services have been swapped over to the new main. The only remaining work is a couple of side streets and then clean-up. This project will eliminate over a mile of cast iron pipe that we had two breaks on last winter.

Second Street – We met with the City and a representative of the contractor. Work will start between Mill and Dunn Streets at the end of June. The Gas Company is set to re-locate their main as it is directly on top of the existing water main.

Maple Point Rd - There is a section of Maple Point, between Poland and Manley Roads that I would like for us to replace this summer. This project was not planned or budgeted for but if we have the funds and can fit it into our schedule, I would like to

do this later in the summer. I will have a full project estimate at the June Trustee Meeting.

#### **Old Business**

#### Sustainable Water Supply Alternatives

The Sub-Committee has not met in the last month. I am waiting on proposals from Weston and Sampson.

#### Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission Update.

The Commission is in the process of updating its watershed management plan, I've forwarded all trustees a draft plan. The Commission is meeting in June. If any trustees have comments, please get those to me before the end of May.

The Commission has hired CDM Smith to investigate directional ground water flow in the area of the Gracelawn Pit. We expect to have the first report back on the study at the end of May.

#### Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission Recommendation Letter

On March 3, 2023 the District received a letter of recommendation from the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission. As requested, I've reviewed the recommendations and compiled my comments in a memo to the AWD Board.

#### Water Quality Update

After Ice-out, water quality this year looked typical. However, a rather large rain event occurred which resulted in severe flooding of the lake and several of the major tributaries into the lake swelled beyond their banks. As a result, Lakeshore Drive overtopped for the second time in 5 months and the road was closed for several days until the waters receded. Significant amounts of nutrients washed into the lake. Lake clarity has decreased since the storm and it is not yet clear what other impacts this storm has had on the Lake.

Our Watershed Manager is working with DOT and DEP to develop a project to replace the failing culvert on Lakeshore Drive. There is the potential to partially fund this work with a mixture of Grants and State match.

#### **Sewer Trustees**

#### Financial Report Highlights

Metered revenue is up 8.5% from this time last year, due to the November rate increase. The variance in expenses is driven by inventory to lower, raise and repair manholes. April ended just below \$1.7 million cash on hand.

#### Project Update

Green Mountain is scheduled to start work in Auburn on May 22. We raised all of the manholes on Vernon and Grove streets for finished paving. Our crew has been working to clean pumping station wet wells, River Station, E-3 and Moose Brook have been cleaned so far. The spare pump for river station has been rebuilt and is ready for install.

#### **Old Business**

#### Washington Street Pumping Station Design

Wright-Pierce gave an overview of the geo-technical work and some of their preliminary thoughts on the Washington Street Pumping Station.

#### Mall Area Sewer Improvements/ Funding

I received the attached quote from Gendron of \$100,000 to upgrade a small section of sewer. I was in a meeting with Dan Goyette and he had an excellent suggestion that will eliminate the need to upgrade this sewer now or in the future if the Gracelawn development occurs. Gendron is already planning to replace the existing sewer main where it crosses Mt Auburn Ave. Rather than replace this section it is suggested to leave the sewer as is and install a new 12" stub across the street closer to BJs. If there is a need in the future to up-size the sewer the stub will be out of the street for access by the contractor.

#### APPROVE MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING of March 22, 2023

On a motion of Eric Gould, seconded by Kevin Arel, it was unanimously voted: **To accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting.** 

## EXECUTIVE SESSION IN ACCORDANCE with 1 M.S.R.A. § 405 (6) (E) to DISCUSS A LEGAL MATTER

On a motion of Andrew Titus, seconded by Robert Cavanagh, it was unanimously voted: **To move into executive session.** 

The meeting was called to order at 4:23p.m.

#### FINANCIAL REPORT UPDATE

Water sales were down in March approximately 3%, leaving a \$21,000 variance in metered revenues. March ended with \$3.5 million cash on hand.

#### RATIFY PAYMENT OF BILLS

On a motion of Robert Cavanagh, seconded by Kevin Arel, it was unanimously voted: To ratify payment of bills in the amount of \$402,291.51 as shown on the printout dated March 1, 2023 – March 31, 2023.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Stephen Beale questioned the progress of the Stable Ridge Development corrective actions required for the District to take over ownership of the booster station. Superintendent Broadbent responded that there has been progress, however, all items have not been corrected. The District is operating the station, however, ownership will not be transferred until all items have been corrected.

Mr. Beale also commented that the lawsuit filed against the District is due to actions of the City of Auburn. He questioned if the District will bring responsibility of these actions to the City. President Milks responded that the District has maintained its commitment to the rate payers and that the attorney is taking care of litigation and the PUC complaint.

#### **ACTIVITY REPORT / PROJECT UPDATE**

Main breaks have tapered off. The crew is transitioning from maintenance work to projects. Gendron is extending both water and sewer mains on Mount Auburn Avenue. The crew will start off with eliminating 5,000 feet of cast iron main on Hotel Road. The Second Street project has been awarded; the start of the project is delayed because of the contractor's availability. This means some of the work will not be completed this year including the planned water improvements. The new high school has its meter and the water is on.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **Sustainable Water Supply Alternative**

The Sustainable Water Supply Alternative Committee reviewed the Weston and Sampson presentation from the prior meeting. The next steps are to look into the feasibility of extending the intake and research potential ground water sources within 1 mile of the AWD infrastructure.

#### Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission Update

The Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission, LAWPC, authorized staff to hire CDM Smith to obtain certainty of the watershed boundary. This work will include researching existing test wells to find the direction of ground water flow.

Bates College conducted a study of the proximity of septic systems to Lake Auburn. Superintendent Broadbent will review the study and the possibility of a DEP 319 Grant to remedy issues if necessary.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **Water Quality Update**

Water quality at this time is trending normal. Ice out was April 12th. More sampling will occur now that the ice is out.

#### TRUSTEE OPEN SESSION

As no Trustee had comment, the Trustee Open Session was closed.

On a motion of Robert Cavanagh seconded by Kevin Arel, it was unanimously voted: **To adjourn.** Meeting adjourned at 5:07 p.m.

Trustees of the Auburn Water District,

This letter is addressed to you on behalf of the Commissioners of the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission. This Commission was formed in 1993 with the principal purpose to maintain safe and healthful environmental conditions within the Lake Auburn Watershed, to prevent and control water pollution, and to protect and maintain the present quality and volume of potable water supplied from the Lake Auburn Watershed. In fulfilment of this purpose, Commissioners began reviewing changes being proposed by the City of Auburn to regulations within the Lake Auburn watershed last year. This process included conducting a peer review of the environmental studies being used by the City of Auburn in drafting new regulations, consultation with environmental engineers, and discussion at LAWPC meetings to assess the outcomes of these review processes.

Through this review process, Commissioners have concluded that additional regulation should be considered to maintain safe and healthful environmental conditions within the Lake Auburn Watershed, to prevent and control water pollution, and to protect and maintain the present quality and volume of potable water supplied from the Lake Auburn Watershed.

Commissioners reviewed the following documents in developing their recommendations regarding changes to regulations within the Lake Auburn Watershed:

- A Regulatory, Environmental, and Economic Analysis of Water Supply Protection in Auburn, Maine prepared by FB Environmental Associates, Horsely Witten Group and the University of Maine, dated October 2021.
- Lake Auburn Model Technical Memorandum addressed to Eric Cousens, City of Auburn, prepared by Laura Diemer, FB Environmental Associates, dated August 1, 2022.
- Watershed Delineation Rezoning Review Gravel Pit Parcel Lake Auburn Watershed
  Protection Commission prepared by Robert H. Fitzgerald and Anne E. Malenfant, CDM Smith,
  dated June 22, 2022, and revised October 5, 2022.
- Peer Review of FB Environmental Associates A Regulatory, Environmental, and Economic
   Analysis of Water Supply Protection in Auburn, Maine dated October 2021 and the
   supplemental Lake Auburn Model Technical Memorandum dated August 1, 2022 prepared by

Rebecca Balke and Eileen Pannetier, Comprehensive Environmental Inc, dated December 5, 2022.

During their January 10, 2023 meeting, Commissions voted to adopt the following recommendation:

The Commissioners of LAWPC recommend that the Trustees of the Auburn Water District develop rules and policies within the watershed of Lake Auburn in order to implement the following regulatory recommendations:

#### Specific to Auburn

- Moratorium on siting of septic systems within a 400 foot buffer around Lake Auburn.
- Moratorium on new development within the boundaries of the AGRP zone within Auburn.
- Alum treatments be scheduled as needed based on regular monitoring rather than on a predetermined schedule.
- Any future development, based on changes to the watershed boundary on the Gracelawn Rd property, is required to monitor surface and ground water to ensure that water does not flow into the watershed.

#### Specific to the Entire Watershed

- A system of oversight for the installation of any new mounded wastewater systems be created and implemented to ensure proper installation. This system should include inspection prior to installation, prior to covering, and after final installation.
- An inspection schedule be developed and implemented for current septic systems.
- Ensure there is a responsible entity for the purpose of monitoring septic systems.
- Require using the most stringent standards for new septic systems, as set forth in the Maine Subsurface Disposal Rules chapter 241.
- Failing systems be replaced using the updated standards required for new installations.
- Create requirements for the replacement of older septic systems upon transfer of real estate within the watershed.
- Low Impact Development (LID) standards be implemented.
- Identify areas to be conserved in the upper watershed.
- Prohibit large scale disbursement of organic and synthetic fertilizers.

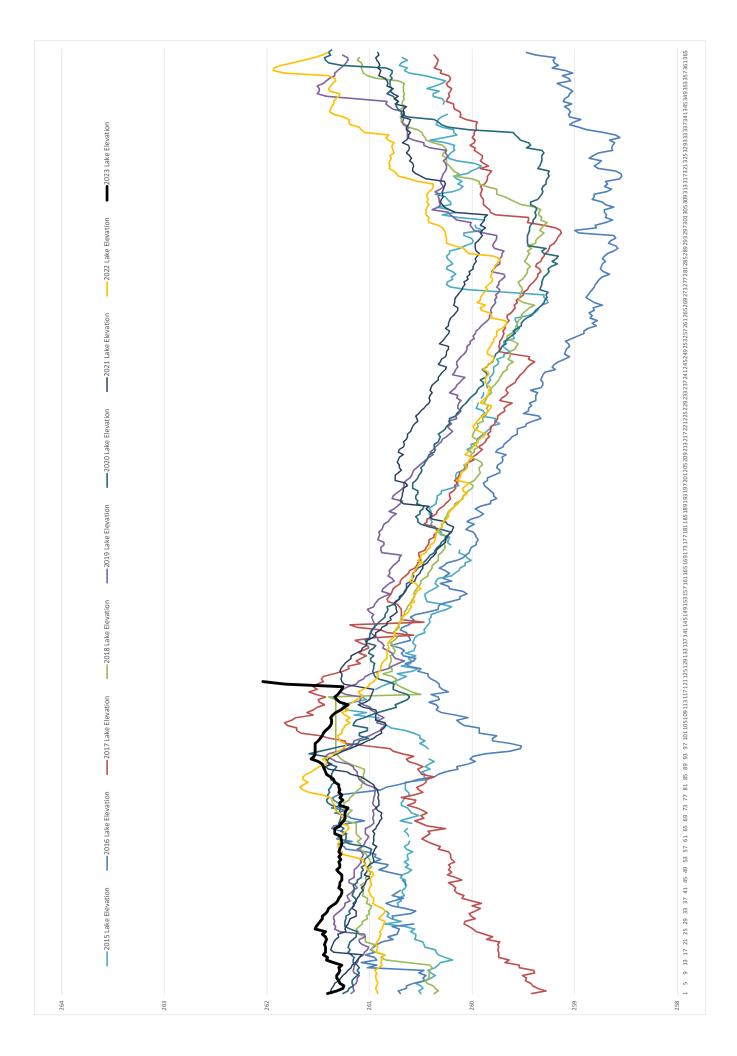

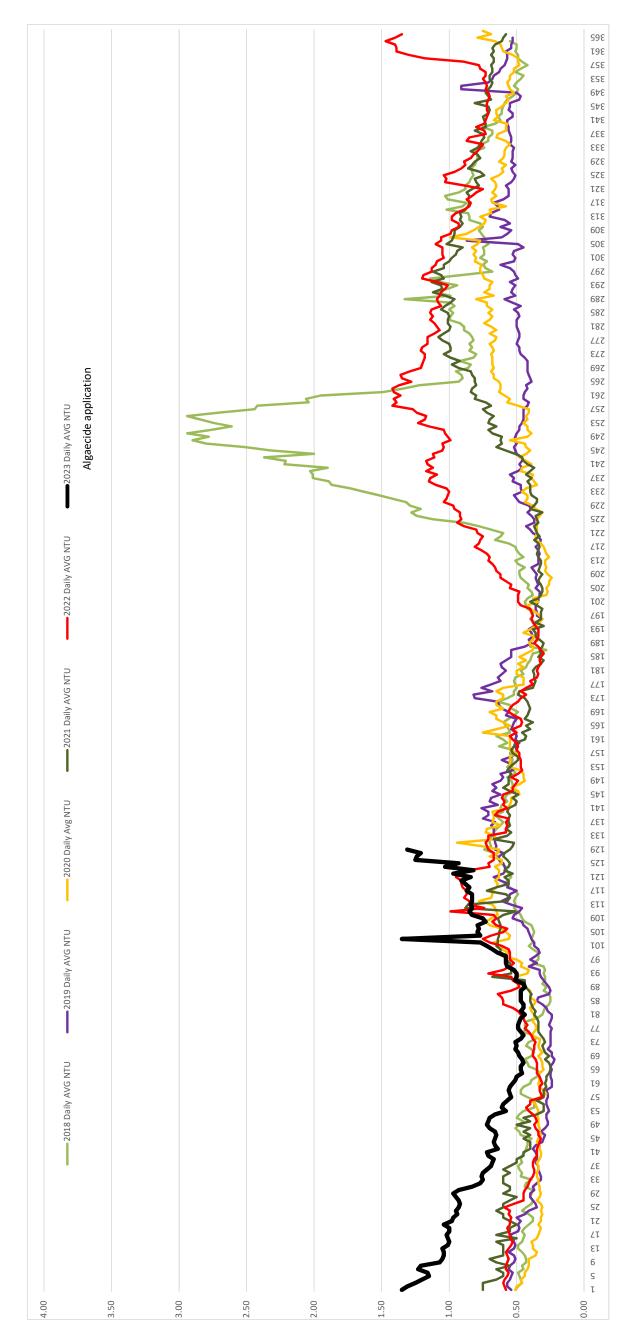

The District received a draft copy of the 2022 Audit in April of 2023. I've reviewed the Audit with our past Financial Director and will go over the Audit with our new Finance Director after she is acclimated with the position. With the Transition of this position, it is an opportune time to implement new practices and procedures. I would like to allow the new Finance Director to become familiar with the position and its responsibilities. Then we'll work to implement the recommended changes that I've summarized below.

There are a few action items that the District needs to attend to. During our conversations with the Auditors, it was suggested that the District adopt a formal purchasing policy. We were surprised to see that it was not recommended in the Management letter but we firmly believe a purchasing policy could be beneficial to the District.

The management letter had two specific recommendations, develop a policy for routine accounting practices and reconcile all general ledger accounts in a timely manner. The policy on accounting practices is in my opinion an easy fix. I feel that as the new Finance Director learns the roles here at the district, our practices can be outlined in an SOP format. This will help ensure nothing falls through the cracks in the future. Currently the District reconcile's our ledger annually, monthly reconciliations would be extremely difficult given our current structure. After discussing this with Tanya, we would like to recommend quarterly reconciliations.

**Re:** March 3, 2023 the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission (LAWPC) sent the Auburn Water District (AWD) a letter of recommendation on a variety of watershed protection items.

I've reviewed all of the recommendations and I offer the following recommendations/action.

#### Specific to Auburn:

- Moratorium on siting septic systems within a 400' buffer around Lake Auburn. The City is taking action on a 300' Buffer.
- Moratorium on new development within the boundaries of the AGRP zone within Auburn. The
  City is taking action to change the Agriculture and Resource Protection zone that is within the
  watershed of Lake Auburn to a Conservation and Natural Resource Protection that would
  prohibit new residential development. This will affect 73% of the Watershed lands in Auburn.
- Alum treatments be scheduled as needed based on regular monitoring rather than on a
  predetermined schedule. This is the current practice, alum treatments a done as needed. The
  Commission is conducting a study on potential dosing stations that would be installed on
  tributaries leading into the Lake.
- Any future development, based on changes to the watershed boundary on the Gracelawn Rd
  property, is required to monitor surface and ground water to ensure that water does not flow
  into the watershed. This is accomplished through the storm water management plan which the
  City requires of all development. Large projects are sent to a third party for review and approval
  purposes.

#### Specific to the entire watershed:

- A system of oversight for the installation of any new mounded wastewater systems to be created and implemented to ensure proper installation. This system should include inspection prior to installation, prior to covering, and after final installation. The District and COA staff should sit down and discuss the options to achieve this Goal. My feeling is this should be funded through the Watershed so that the costs are appropriately apportioned. There is the possibility that the COA could also contribute to this effort and this position could be combined with the Education and Outreach coordinator.
- An inspection schedule be developed and implemented for current septic systems. See above comments.
- Ensure there is a reasonable entity for the purpose of monitoring septic systems. If the commission took on this task it would ensure oversight is shared between all users of water.
- Require using the most stringent standards for new septic systems, as set forth in the Maine Subsurface Disposal Rules chapter 241. The City of Auburn has examined this and is in the process of implementation. This has been slowed by the lawsuit and the conflicting recommendations and opinions of mounded systems. I would recommend a staff level meeting with District, COA and LWD representatives at the table to discuss this topic. I feel at this time all sides seem to agree on a path forward yet we can't openly discuss it because of litigation.
- Failing systems be replaced using the updated standards required for new installations. See above comment
- Create requirements for the replacement of old septic systems upon transfer of real estate within the watershed. This could be considered as part of the update of the By-Laws for the protection of Lake Auburn.
- Low Impact Development (LID) standards to be implemented. The City has already adopted a new LID standard. Date??
- Identify areas to be conserved in the upper watershed. The Commission has a draft land
  acquisition policy that has not formally been adopted. The District should suggest to the
  commission to adopt this practice as policy.
- Prohibit large scale disbursement of organic and synthetic fertilizers. Discuss this with the City and see if there are current restrictions.

All of these recommendations are consistent with the current discussions regarding the Lake and Watershed. The District needs to continue to work with the City to follow through on the recommendations and to ensure that the new practices are followed once adopted. One recommendation would be for the District to formally create an ordinance for the protection of Lake Auburn that is consistent with these recommendations. This would require future changes be made by the District rather than the City. My second recommendation would be that the District consult with our legal team to better understand it's authority in the upper watershed towns. It is important to understand what authority we have in other municipalities and who is obligated to enforce our ordinances. Formal correspondence and communication should start well in advance of changes to current practices.
